

The software is Jixipix for Windows and MAC. This software is used as Photoshop Plug in and Lightroom.

The product is 3 Pro Products, including Watercolor Studio, Chromatic Edges, and Impresso.

Chromatic Edges: Multiple edges and image post processing changes such as, Cyanotype, Daguerreotype, Gelatin, Silver, etc.

Impresso Pro transforms photos into paintings and then combines paint effects with layers and brushes.

Watercolor Studio: Changes image into a watercolor image with adjustable sliders.


